Metro Kalyn Community Library believes that the safety of the patrons and of employees should always be of the up-most importance. If any doubt exists with regard to personal safety PLEASE DON'T TAKE THE RISK. Bruderheim is a 911 community.

What to do in case of:

Fire

- •Dial 911.
- •Escort all patrons out of the Library.
- •Check bathroom, storage room and meeting room for patrons.
- •Exit the Library.
- •There are 2 fire extinguishers in the Library; near the look-up computer and at the Town of Bruderheim office door. Please familiarize yourself with their locations.

Power Outage

- •Escort all patrons out of the Library.
- •Check the bathroom, storage room and meeting room for patrons.
- •Write and post a sign in the window.
- •Close and lock the Library.

Robbery

- •Follow the thief's demands; do not try to dissuade him/her.
- •Press the panic alarm button.
- •After the thief is out of sight, dial 911.

Threat to Personal Safety

- •Press the panic alarm button.
- •Dial 911.
- •Open the Bruderheim Town Office door as it is alarmed.

Theft

- •Report to Chairperson.
- •Write out all pertinent details as soon as possible.

Injury

- •For serious injuries dial 911.
- •1st Aid kit is on Library Manager's desk. Please familiarize yourself with its location and contents.
- •If a child is injured, after rendering assistance, contact his/her parents.
- •Write down all pertinent details as soon as possible and submit to Supervisor or Chairperson.
