

2. Trusteeship

A. One Trustee Shall be Appointed by Each of the Following:

- i) Town of Lamont
- ii) Lamont County
- iii) Lamont High School

In addition, residents of the area served by the Lamont Public Library may be nominated as a trustee for a three-year term. Trustees may be nominated for more than one consecutive term to a maximum of three terms.

a. Honoraria

An annual honorarium shall be paid (optional) to the following:

Chairperson - \$250.00

Treasurer - \$250.00

Secretary - \$250.00

A review of the above may take place at any scheduled meeting of the Library Board.

b. Expenses for Trustees

Trustees are encouraged to attend in-service training. Reasonable expenses connected with trustees' attendance at conferences and workshops will be paid as the budget permits. No honoraria, per meeting, or per diem costs will be paid. Other costs incurred on library-related business may be considered on an individual basis.

3. Materials

3.1 General

Since the library cannot acquire all materials, it must employ a policy of selectivity in acquisition which recognizes its informational, educational and recreational functions. Selection is based specifically on the particular needs and interests of the library's community, both of individuals and of organizations. The selection of books is designed to make available significant materials actually and potentially needed by, and of interest to, library patrons. The library seeks to maintain a basic circulating collection chosen to answer general interest requests from the community.

A. Responsibility

Shared responsibility for book selection rests with the school and public librarians. They select in accordance with the stated library objectives and a general overview of the entire book collection and library service role.
